#### Ⅳ 次の英文を読み,以下の各問に答えなさい。

Do you know the proverb "Everything comes to him who waits"? It means that if you wait patiently, good chances and good luck will come your way.

Ed Dwight was born in 1933 in Kansas City. When he was a child, he enjoyed building toy planes in his backyard and working with his hands. After entering elementary school, he worked as a newspaperman. One day, while delivering newspapers, he read an article about Dayton Ragland. Dayton was a black man from Kansas City and a pilot in the United States Air Force. Dwight was surprised that black men worked near airplanes. In those days, black people were discriminated against, so ① (difficult/get/them/to/was/for/it) a job. Dwight was proud of Dayton and decided to get the same job. After graduating from college, he became an Air Force pilot in 1953. Dwight trained hard to be a Fighter pilot and also studied engineering.

In the 1960s, ② the U.S. government (skilled / pilots / than / more / needed) those in the Soviet Union. President John F. Kennedy and NASA selected 14 candidates from the Air Force and scientists. Kennedy also wanted to solve the racial problem, so he selected black pilots as a bridge between other races. As a result, Dwight was selected as the first Black astronaut candidate. Unfortunately, however, he wasn't selected because Kennedy was killed. After that, Dwight retired from the Air Force and became a businessman. Sixty years later, Blue Origin, an American aerospace manufacturer, invented a manned space flight. An NPO supported this business and selected astronauts. At the age of ninety, Dwight got a chance to go to space. On May 19, 2024, he flew on Blue Origin's New Shepard and experienced weightlessness for ten minutes. He became the oldest person to fly in space at 90 years 8 months and 10 days. He called it "a life challenging experience." He said "I thought I really didn't need this in my life... I am ecstatic."
